EHCP Writing Outsourcing in the UK:

Costs and Considerations for Councils

The number of EHCPs issued in England has been steadily increasing since their introduction in 2014 as part of the SEND reforms. This has placed a significant strain on Local Authorities (LAs), leading many to explore outsourcing EHCP writing as a potential solution. It is estimated that roughly one in three LAs has outsourced the production of draft EHCPs to third-party firms. This report examines the practice of EHCP writing outsourcing in the UK, focusing on the costs and considerations for councils.



Reasons for Outsourcing

Councils face several challenges in managing the EHCP writing process in-house. One of the primary challenges is the increasing volume of EHCPs and the resulting fluctuation in workloads. In January 2024, there were **576,000** children with EHCPs, a **140%** increase since 2015. The sheer volume of work can be overwhelming for SEND case officers, who often have unmanageable caseloads, sometimes in the hundreds. This impacts the timeliness of plan development, with only **50%** of plans completed within the required 20-week timeframe in many areas in 2024.

Furthermore, workloads can fluctuate unpredictably, making it difficult for councils to manage staffing levels effectively. High workloads and a lack of training focused on SEND Caseworkers' development contributes to staff retention issues, leading to a constant need to recruit and train new staff.

Benefits

Drawbacks

Potential for reduced "co-production":

"Co-production" is a core principle of the SEND reforms, emphasising the active involvement of families and young people in the EHCP process, ensuring that their views and wishes are considered.

Data protection concerns:

When outsourcing EHCP writing, councils must ensure that any external provider used will handle sensitive data securely and comply with data protection regulations.

Potential for communication breakdowns:

Clear communication and coordination between the council and the outsourcing provider are essential for successful implementation.

Risk of inconsistent quality:

While outsourcing can lead to improved plan quality, there is also a **risk of inconsistent quality if providers are not carefully selected and monitored**. Councils need to establish clear quality standards and implement ongoing monitoring and evaluation.

Potential impact on other services:

Outsourcing EHCP writing may have **unintended consequences for other SEND services** with poor quality EHCPs causing further work for staff and delays to children and families.



The Role of Technology

Technology can play a significant role in streamlining the EHCP writing process and improving timeliness.
